TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **USBC CERTIFIED tournament.** Eligible persons who are not USBC members must pay a \$5.00 tournament participation fee or pay the season membership of \$19.00. Eligible women who are not USBC members must pay a tournament participation fee of \$5.00 or the unattached fee of \$19.00. These fees must be paid prior to bowling (300c – Tournament Eligibility). Bowlers that only pay the tournament participation fee are not eligible for any USBC awards.
Entry deadline is March 7, 2009, 12:30 pm. before the last squad of bowling. If tournament is full before that date, entries will be put on a waiting list, in the order they were received. All those placed on the waiting list will be taken in order of entry number.
3. Bowlers may enter the tournament as many times as they wish. Not more than three (3) bowlers on the same team can place more than once (1) in the prize list in each division. Your team may not participate in more than one (1) event at a time.
4. All prize fees will be returned 100% within each event. At least one (1) prize for every ten (10) entries will be awarded.
5. For handicapping purposes only, the highest 07-08 Yearbook twenty-one (21) game average will be accepted. If this year's average, as of December 31, 2008, is fifteen (15) pins higher and for at least 21 games, the higher will be used (Rule 319a). Entrants without a Yearbook average but with a current USBC average of twenty-one (21) games or more as of January 31, 2009 the present average will be accepted. Averages from summer leagues will be accepted if no current league average is established. Actual scores bowled will be used to calculate team totals.
6. Bowlers will receive 80% of the difference between their highest average and 220. Bowlers who average over 220 will receive zero. Men without a sanctioned average will be given a 170, women a 160. Failure to use the correct average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower. Bowlers have 48 hours from their date of competition to submit a correct average. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it higher than the correct average; however, corrections in averages are permitted up to the completion of the first game of the series. **Teams whose average exceeds 949 must enter in the Classic Division Only.**
7. **Optional Singles sign-up will only be available at the bowling center and standings will be calculated throughout the tournament using the same handicap rule above.** Unmarried grade or high school students under the age of 18 must have written consent of their parent or guardian. The parental consent form must be received at least one week prior to participation. Youth participants not certified, shall pay a \$2.00 tournament participation fee.
8. Bowlers who have won money or merchandise in any tournaments over the past year, more than \$600.00, must report amount won and scores bowled and are subject to re-rating. Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings. (Rule 319d)
9. The tournament reserves the right to re-rate any bowler on the information provided. Re-rating of a bowler will be done prior to bowling. If adjusted average is unacceptable, money will be refunded. (Rule 319c)
10. Participants should be aware of USBC Rule 319d and 319e pertaining to adjustment of average. A bowler shall be responsible for maintaining a record of names, dates, scores and prize winnings of all tournaments in which he/she has competed in the previous twelve months, including those still running. A bowler whose tournament scores required an average adjustment of his/her entering average must submit that adjusted average in writing before bowling or prior to completion of the first game in the series of this tournament.
11. Members of the PBA or LPBT and non-members whom we determine to be professionals will be permitted to enter this tournament in the Classic Division Only. These bowlers shall also be members of USBC.
12. This is a team event only. There are three (3) divisions: Men's, Mixed and Classic. Teams in the Mixed Division must have at least two (2) women.
13. \$300 prize will be awarded to those eligible persons who bowl a perfect 300 game. Ineligible individuals are:
 - 1) Professional bowlers or those that have been professional in the last 24 months.
 - 2) Persons that have or have had an average of 200 or more in the past 24 months.
 - 3) Current or former employees of the sponsor, or any promotions or advertising agency involved with this promotion.
 - 4) Family members, agents, successors of assignees of any of the above.
 - 5) Misrepresentation of fact as to eligibility, whether intentional or unintentional, shall be sufficient cause to forfeit any prize awarded by the sponsor.
14. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto or there from, fire, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the Downriver Firefighters shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or other wise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
